Transfer to hotel on your own


Full day at leisure to explore Copenhagen's sights and neighborhoods including "The Little Mermaid" statue in Copenhagen harbor

Day 4: Train Copenhagen to Stockholm (approx 5 hours)

Arrive in the afternoon in the Venice of the North, Sweden's breathtaking capital city with endless waterways connecting the various islands that make up Stockholm.

Time to explore the gorgeous landscapes of Stockholm, including Stockholm City Hall (Radshus) where the Nobel Prize is awarded every year, Gamla Stan (Old Town), the Vasa Museum, housing a 17th Century Warship, and so much more.

Day 5: More time to explore this beautiful city!

Take in the natural beauty of Djurgarden and EkoParken, Europe's only urban National Park, ride a bike or kayak around the waterways that surround the city, visit the open air museum of Skansen depicting Swedish traditional life of a bygone eras, journey out to the Swedish Royal Palace at Drottningholm, or just enjoy the fun and excitement of Grona Lund, Stockholm's center city amusement park. In the evening, take in sumptuous Swedish cuisine at any number of excellent restaurants around the city, or take in some of Europe's greatest jazz at Stampen Jazz Club in the heart of the Old City

Day 6: Full day at leisure for more exploring or shopping around Stockholm

5PM – Depart Stockholm by overnight ferry to Helsinki.

Enjoy the spectacular views of the Stockholm Archipelago as you cruise the Baltic on this overnight adventure to Helsinki.

Day 7: Arrive mid morning into Helsinki

Full day to explore this beautiful city on the Baltic including Helsinki Cathedral, the spectacular fortress of Suomenlinaa, Finlandia Hall concert hall, the Sibelius Monument, Mannerheim Museum, and breathtaking Tuoolenrantaa Park, with beautiful inlets coming in from the Baltic. Or ride the Sparakoff Pub Tram all around the city for a unique sightseeing tour of the Finnish Capital.

In the evening, take in the White Night (depending on time of year), with world-renowned Finnish Cuisine at any number of restaurants around this gastronomically-conscious mecca for food in Scandinavia.
